

HEALTH AND SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AT LEXINGTON CLINIC SURGERY CENTERS

The well-being of our patients, visitors and staff remains our top priority. We have safety measures in place to keep everyone safe and protected from exposure to COVID-19 during appointments, surgeries and procedures at our surgery center.

VISITOR GUIDELINES

- Visitors are not permitted at this time, except for the following:
 - Pediatric surgical patients will be allowed one parent/guardian visitor.
 - Patients that need additional assistance or have a medical power of attorney will be allowed one visitor.
- Accompanying visitor will be screened alongside the patient prior to entering the surgery center building. If the visitor has fever or any other symptoms of respiratory illness, he/she will be instructed to leave the facility and seek care.
- The visitor must remain in a designated waiting room during the procedure or surgery, while maintaining social distancing guidelines.

VISITOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Wear a mask at all times.
- Maintain proper social distancing while in our facility.
- Perform frequent hand hygiene by washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or by using an alcohol-based hand rub for at least 20 seconds.
- Follow respiratory hygiene and cough etiquette (i.e. cover mouth and nose with a disposable tissue when coughing or sneezing).
- Notify a member of the staff immediately if you develop signs and symptoms of COVID-19 while at our facility.
