For Our Patients:

In Our Facilities:

- Our in-house cleaning and sanitization processes are comprehensive, with a continued emphasis on proper personal hygiene to include frequent hand-washing and proper use of sanitizers.
- We are also studying the availability of our supplies and potential substitutes and alternative sourcing.

For Our Physicians and Employees:

- We know that education is key and we are keeping our physicians and employees updated regarding COVID-19 on a daily basis.
- We have shared our Plan of Action with all of our team members in case they come in contact with a potential COVID-19 patient.
- We have suspended all non-essential business travel.

Wash your hands with soap and water frequently and cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or your elbow if you have to sneeze or cough.
